Made in Athens about 350 - 250 BC
Found to be from Athens
The boy wears an ivy wreath, perhaps indicating that he is taking part in a festival for the wine god Dionysos. To his side is a small boy with a figure of a satyr, perhaps also an allusion to the cult of Dionysos.

Small figures of Italian boys and girls were common dedications in sanctuaries in southern Italy, such as the sanctuary of Artemis at Spina in the vicinity of Apollonia in Greece and that of Eleuthera in Sicily. This is a youthful portrait of a small smiling boy, with hair-dressed curls and a slight expression.
