- 1** There are quite a few examples of military equipment in **Gallery 49**. Here are just a few!



- 2** The Hoxne Hoard can be seen at one end of **Gallery 49**. It's the richest find of treasure from Roman Britain. It includes around 15,000 coins, jewellery, cutlery and other items of treasure which were buried for safety.



You can see even more on the other side of the cabinet!

- 3** Emperor Hadrian can be found in **Gallery 70**. There are a few busts of him in this gallery. You might even spot him in **Gallery 49** as well! He was the first Emperor to have a beard!



- 4** Did you spot them all? Mosaics show images of boars, stags, birds (including an ostrich!), leopards, stags, gazelles, fish, horses, and cats. You can see some of them in this mosaic



- 5** The Portland vase is made using a technique called cameo glass. We're not 100% sure what it shows. The most common theory is that it shows the wedding of the sea-gods Peleus and Thetis.
